From the Superintendent-

- 1. <u>Community Chest Grant</u>-Dr. Kell to present the District's application for the annual grant through Central DuPage Hospital/Cadence Health on Saturday morning.
- 2. <u>Regional Office of Education Threat Assessment</u>-Dr. Kell gave a summary of the meeting presented by two FBI agents hosted by the Regional Office of Education.
