- STEM lab(s) Update-INFORMATION ITEM-Mrs. Reinke summarized some of the projects that students will work on in the newly transformed computer lab as part of the new STEM curriculum.
- 2. <u>Science and Math Pilots INFORMATION ITEM</u>- Both pilots are underway and we will be collecting feedback regarding them throughout the fall.
- 3. <u>Gifted Curriculum Review Committee Work INFORMATION ITEM</u>- The surveys were completed last spring and the committee is meeting on September 15<sup>th</sup> to review the data. That information will be shared at the next Board meeting.
- 4. <u>Full Day Kindergarten INFORMATION ITEM</u>- We have 26 kindergarten students; 25 of them are full day. Approximately 14 students pay fees, with the remaining meeting at-risk or special ed eligibility. They all seem to be adjusting very well, even in the lunchroom.
