From the Superintendent-

<u>Legislative</u>-Dr. Kell will be attending the LEND breakfast (9-19-14) with guest state legislators. She encourages everyone to call, write letters, and e-mails to their representatives regarding SB16.

<u>Strategic Plan</u>- Dr. Kell reviewed the Strategic Planning process which is underway and how the Board of Education will share this information.

From the Principal-

<u>Review and Accept 2014-15 School Improvement Plan</u>: Dawn Reinke reviewed the 2014-15 School Improvement Plan noting that it is in a new SMART Goal format.

<u>Result of Gifted Surveys:</u> Mrs. Reinke reported the Gifted Committee's findings. In December, she hopes to present the final results of all the data.

From the Director of Business Services-

<u>Review and Approve 2014 Audit Report</u>- Doug Gallois reviewed the 2014 audit report, noting that the audit had no concerns or discrepancies and all numbers reconciled, all in all a very good audit.

<u>Kindergarten</u>- Dr. Kell updated the Board on the kindergarten program since it has begun. We had planned for 25 students to attend, and are now at 26. The Board was asked to consider if another section could be opened in November. If a decision to add a classroom were to be made, the timeframe would be to decide soon to allow for time to prepare the classrooms. The Board discussed their concerns, given the uncertain financial future and that it is easy to add programs, but difficult to eliminate them. It was suggested to continue this discussion when the all board members are present, and additional financial numbers are provided.

<u>5 Year Projections FY14-18</u>-Doug Gallois reviewed and summarized the projections for the next 5 years and how different scenarios can affect the budget moving ahead into 2018. He included how the numbers would look if we added an additional kindergarten teacher. He also gave comparison figures of budgeting for 10% expenses versus 8% expenses and asked the Board for their input on which figure to use in two calculations.

From the Winfield Education Foundation-

<u>Winfield Education Foundation Report</u>-Dave Hempe reported that they are continuing to get the word about the Foundation by passing out brochures at local events such as Good Ole Days. \$2,000 was donated to the District to help offset the cost due to the increased low income enrollment. Central DuPage Hospital matched this amount for a total of \$4,000.
