- B. <u>Social Emotional Learning Presentation-Jessica Peters and Shona Davé-</u> In a powerpoint presentation, Mrs. Peters and Mrs. Davé illustrated the programs in place to support students' emotional needs, including universal support, as well as intensive individualized supports.

## From the Superintendent-

- 1. <u>Recognition of School Board Members' Day November 15, 2015-</u> Dr. Kell thanked the Board, on behalf of the students, staff, and parents, for all they do. She presented them with certificates of appreciation for their work on the Board.
- 2. <u>American Education Week-</u> Dr. Kell explained the ways that administration will celebrate American Education Week, including a special coffee for the crossing guards.

## From the Director of Business Services-

 <u>Approve the 2015 Tax Levy to be Placed on Public Display-</u> Doug Gallois, Director of Business Services, presented a draft of the tax levy for 2015. He summarized how the levy was calculated.

### **Additional Items:**

<u>Capital Projects-Mr</u>. Gallois reviewed the capital projects timeline and presented the details of the paving project behind the Central school.

<u>Updated Projections-</u>Mr. Gallois reviewed the four year projection figures, with the 10% medical costs and property tax freeze that the Board requested.

<u>Electricity</u>-Mr. Gallois was granted authority to take the energy cost out to bid, in an effort to lock in a lower cost for the District over an extended period.

#### **Old Business-**

A. <u>Class Size Discussion</u> – The Board discussed the class size issue and what type of guidelines that they were looking to establish such as; a teacher/student ratio or a high/low range. They felt the administration ultimately knows the students and should be able to continue making these decisions, given all the possible variables involved. They decided to table this discussion, but requested that class size projections be included in the staffing plan to them in the spring.
