From the Principal-

1. <u>Update on Beginning of the Year-</u> Superkids Curriculum up and running, seems to be going well. PTO is hosting an online auction to replace Trivia Night this year. MAPS and Aimsweb testing ongoing, NWEA was hacked recently with a denial of service attack. Road construction is almost complete; students were re-routed during the work.

From the Director of Business Services-

- 1. Review and Approve 2015 Audit Report- Doug Gallois reviewed the 2015 audit report, noting that the audit had no concerns or discrepancies and all numbers reconciled, all in all a very good audit.
- 2. <u>Updated Projections</u> Doug Gallois reviewed and summarized the projections for the next 4 years FY16-FY19, and how different scenarios can affect the budget moving ahead into 2019. His comparison figures showed two different scenarios, one that had the other expenses at 3%, and the other at 6% medical with a property tax freeze. Based on trends in insurance rates, the Board requested projections reflecting a 10% increase to medical insurance. Mr. Gallois will bring those figures to the Board at the November or December Board meeting.
- 3. <u>Future Capital Projects List and Current Capital Budget-INFORMATION ITEM</u>- Doug Gallois presented an overview of the three proposed Capital Projects for FY16 and the costs associated with these projects. The projects are: air control systems in both schools, window replacement in the primary school, and pave/ground water control repairs.

From the Winfield Education Foundation-
